### Procedures for School Club Registration – Autumn 2018

Overleaf are details of our exciting range of pre school, lunchtime and after school activities for the autumn term. Clubs will be available to book via your Scopay account from **Friday 7th September at approximately 4pm.**

When securing your place in a club, you will be required to add a tick in the consent box and enter any important collection information within the dialogue box i.e. Permission given to walk home, permission given to cycle home. This facility instantly provides the school office with your consent and collection arrangements at the point of booking and eliminates the need to complete and return a club registration form prior to the clubs commencing.

Club booking facilities will close at midday on Monday 10th September, so clubs may commence week of 17<sup>th</sup> September and finish week ending 7th December. Any exclusions are detailed on the timetable overleaf. All after school clubs finish at 4.30pm.

**Please ensure that you take note of any dates that clubs are not running from the timetable overleaf. If your child is unable to attend any session, please ensure that the school office is notified by email or telephone in advance, so we understand that they are absent with parental consent rather than missing.**

Your child will be escorted to the red pedestrian gate at 4.30pm for collection. If you are unable to collect your child at 4.30pm, please telephone the school office who will be happy to arrange transfer to our OWLS after school club (a charge of £12 will apply). No child will be allowed to leave unaccompanied, unless permission has been received in advance.
