Occasionally, we are offered additional trips/workshops that are of great benefit to the children in their academic and personal development. These trips are sometimes offered at short notice and at a greatly discounted price (for example year 5 visited the Royal Opera House to see a performance of Swan Lake by the Royal Ballet Company). Should we be offered any additional trips this academic year, we will do our best to inform you as soon as possible.

We will email information regarding each trip/workshop at least 2 weeks prior to the trip/workshop taking place. This letter will detail specific instructions for each trip, including lunch arrangements, additional requirements and payment deadline. The trip/workshop will be available for payment on www.scopay.com at this time. If you have difficulty arranging an online payment, you can make a cash or cheque payment to the school office.

No child will be excluded from the trip based on their inability to pay. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals please contact me to discuss what financial support is available.

Under no circumstances will a pupil be taken on a school trip without prior consent by parents/guardians. Please ensure you give your consent by ticking the Consent Box on your scopay account. If you are paying cash or a cheque to the school office you will need to give written consent for the trip by completing a short form at reception.
