Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are aware that in the current economic climate it is helpful to be able to budget for additional expenditure. Therefore we would like to take this opportunity to let you know about our forthcoming school trips and workshops. All trips relevant to your child's class have been uploaded on the scopay portal already. This will enable you to make payments over a longer period of time but please ensure you arrange payment for relevant trips by their specified deadline.

We will email information regarding each trip/workshop at least 2 weeks prior to the trip/workshop taking place. This letter will detail specific instructions for each trip, including lunch arrangements, additional requirements and payment deadline.

No child will be excluded from the trip based on their inability pay. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals please contact me to discuss what financial support is available.

All trips and workshops have been carefully selected to enrich your child's learning and to support the curriculum in your child's year.
