Parent Feedback

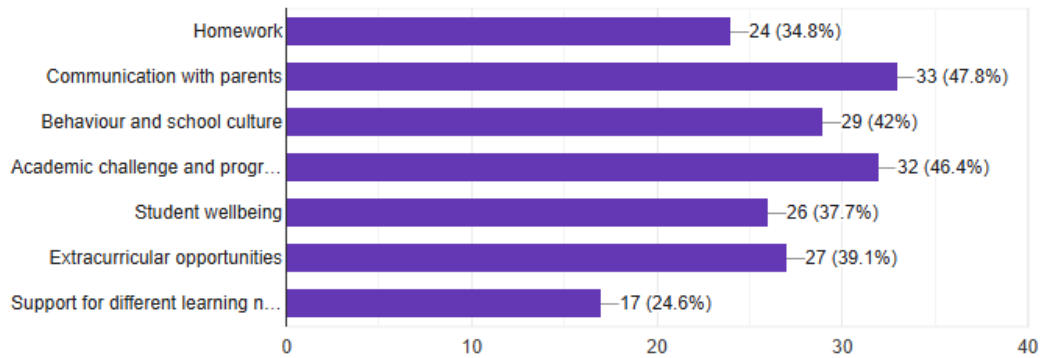
