EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO: Runnymede Meadows, Old Windsor Jurors chairs Art trip

In Art we have chosen to explore the Great British Values and to support this, we will be visiting an art installation, The Jurors, in Runnymede Meadows. These were created by Hew Locke to celebrate the 800th anniversary of the sealing of the Magna Carta and consist of twelve bronze chairs, each depicting a different aspect of freedom and liberty. This will inspire the children to create their own artwork.

As the whole trip will take place outside, please ensure your child dresses appropriately. They must have a bag containing: **water bottle and a waterproof coat and/or a sun hat and cream** depending on the weather. Please also remind your child to bring in **trainers** to wear on the trip to change into before they leave. **Your child will also require packed lunch for this trip.**
