Sythwood 0 - 3 New Haw

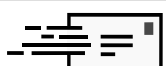

Summer Uniform

When we return after the holiday, all pupils are invited to wear summer uniform, which includes the white summer polo shirt with school logo. Polo shirts without the logo **do not** form part of our uniform - they are appropriate for weekend/evening wear, but not for school.

- Skirts or trousers should be grey and **not black**.

- Shorts must be grey and knee length (this applies to both boys and girls)
