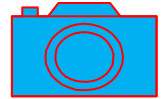

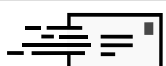

My Chinese World Championships Adventure!

Before flying to China for the World Championships training was very tough. Every day I trained very hard (sometimes until 10 o'clock at night having started at 6:45am) to fulfil the dream of competing at this competition. I had made it.

A very long flight followed the intense training and we arrived in Putian at 2:30am after travelling for over 20hrs.

The competition was held over 2 days. We had our Balance routine on the first day and our Dynamic routine the second day. We had to finish in the top 4 to qualify for the finals which were also to take place on the Thursday. Only China, USA and 2 groups from Russia to beat then!!

We qualified in third place behind the 2 Russian groups but, as only one group from each country would qualify for finals, we went through in second place, although I still say we were third.

Through to the Finals of a World Championships. Finally I was going to compete against the best in the world at a sport I have loved with a passion since I was 4 or 5.

It was nerve racking but also exciting. We scored our highest points of the entire completion and beat the USA by 1 whole point (equal to 10 actual points as scoring is done in decimals), yet didn't quite match the high scoring Russians.

A silver Medal at my first Worlds felt amazing. To have the Union Jack raised aloft while the national anthems were played was a very proud moment.

I have now stopped competing at Acrobatic Gymnastics to try my hand (and feet) at other sports.

Onwards and upwards.... Olympics 2020 here we come!!
